WORKPLACE GIVING

Give to Gathang, straight from your pay

Walk with us. Workplace giving lets you support the continuation of Gathang language and culture with a small, regular donation from your pay — set up once through your employer's payroll, with no fuss at tax time. Your gift helps Gathangga Wakulda Aboriginal Corporation (GWAC) create language spaces, cultural programs and learning opportunities across Birrbay, Warrimay and Guringay Country.

What is workplace giving?

Workplace giving (also called payroll giving) is a simple way to donate to a charity directly from your salary. You choose an amount to give each pay — for example \$5, \$10 or \$20 — and your payroll team deducts it and sends it to GWAC on your behalf. You can change or stop your giving at any time.

For employees — how to nominate GWAC

1. Let your payroll or HR team know you'd like to give to Gathangga Wakulda Aboriginal Corporation through workplace giving. Share the GWAC details below so they can set it up.
2. Choose your amount per pay and confirm it's an ongoing deduction. Even a few dollars each fortnight adds up across a workplace.
3. Payroll sets it up and remits your donation to GWAC each pay run. That's it — your giving continues automatically until you change it.

The tax benefit

GWAC is endorsed as a **deductible gift recipient (DGR)** — donations of \$2 or more are tax-deductible. With workplace giving the benefit usually reaches you **in every pay** — your employer reduces the tax withheld on the donated amount, so you don't need to keep receipts or claim at tax time. Your gift goes further at no extra cost to you.

For employers & payroll teams

Setting up workplace giving for GWAC takes only a few minutes and very little ongoing admin:

- Add Gathangga Wakulda Aboriginal Corporation as a workplace-giving recipient in your payroll system, using the details below.

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- Each pay run, deduct the amount each participating employee has nominated.
- Reduce the PAYG withholding on the donated amount so employees receive the benefit each pay, per ATO workplace-giving guidance.
- Remit the total by EFT to GWAC's account with the agreed payment reference, and provide employees a payslip line and an annual giving summary.

Frequently asked questions

Is there a minimum? No — give what feels right. Many people start at \$5 or \$10 a pay.

Can I change or stop anytime? Yes — just let your payroll team know. Your giving is always voluntary.

Where does my donation go? Directly to GWAC's language and cultural work — community-led programs that keep Gathang strong, spoken and lived.

Will my employer know the amount? Your payroll team processes the deduction, but GWAC only ever sees what you choose to share.
